## HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

- ❖ Begin with prayer for the Holy Spirit to guide you into truth (John 14:16-17, 26).
- ❖ If you wish, mark, write in, or highlight your Bible to identify key insights.
- ❖ Read prayerfully, humbly and slowly to enjoy God's Word.
- ❖ Not everyone likes to journal, but if you do, jot down your observations, questions, insights, etc. Then discuss what God is revealing to you from your journal with your Bible Companion.

## OVERVIEW AND REVIEW

The "Overview" day(s) will help you first see the big picture of a book of the Bible before you start reading. Use a study Bible to learn the main themes, context, characters, book outline, why it was written, etc.

Your "Review" day(s) provide extra days to catch up on your reading or to more deeply reflect on what God is saying to you through scripture.

## WALKING WITH THE WORD
