- 1. Compare these passages: Matthew 27:57-60, Mark 15:42-46, Luke 23:50-53, John 19:38-42. What additional information do we learn about Joseph of Arimathea from these passages?
- 2. How might it be significant that women were the first see the risen Jesus in Matthew's gospel? Matthew 28:1-10
- 3. Why do you think Matthew included the account of the chief priests paying off the guards? Matthew 27:62-66, 28:11-15
- 4. Even with the risen Jesus standing before the disciples, "some doubted." What might cause us to doubt the presence of God in our lives? Matthew 28:17
- 5. The last few verses of Matthew's gospel are often called "The Great Commission" as they are Jesus's last instructions to the disciples. What are some ways in which we can live out the Great Commission today? Matthew 28:18-20
