Refrigerator Prayer Wall

Use some space on your refrigerator to write with magnets the names of each family member's friends. Place magnetic strips on the pictures to represent things you can pray for your friends. You could also attach magnets to the back of photos of your friends and put them on the refrigerator instead of using the alphabet magnets. Each time someone opens the refrigerator, pray for a friend listed on the wall using one of the prayer ideas.
