- 1. What aspects of the centurion's life impressed the elders of the Jews and impressed Jesus? How might we imitate the example of the centurion? Luke 7:1-10
- 2. In what ways did Jesus's miracles elevate his reputation? How far did his reputation extend? Luke 7:11-18
- 3. Do you think that Jesus's answer to John's question is adequate? Why would these signs be meaningful to John?

  Luke 7:19-23
- 4. In this passage, Jesus argues that the woman "who lived a sinful life" better appreciates the forgiveness Jesus offers than the Pharisee. How might our past impact our receptivity to Jesus?

  Luke 7:36-43
- 5. In what way does Jesus reimagine the idea of "family" in this passage? Do you think Jesus's birth family would have been offended by this comment? Luke 8:19-21
