

Church on Campus Frequently Asked Questions

As of 9/21/20

How many worship services will we have?

We will have two worship services at 9 and 10:30 AM, both in-person and live-streamed. Seating will be limited to 25% capacity in the Sanctuary. Additional seating will be available on the Patio to watch the livestream. Children's programming will be available during the 10:30 AM service for Nursery through 5th grade. Junior High and High School will also have programming each week at 10:30 AM.

What are the expectations of people attending Church on Campus?

- Please maintain 6 feet of physical distancing and allow 4 empty chairs between households.
- Please wear cloth masks over your nose and mouth.
- Please stay home if you or anyone in your household is ill.

Do all staff, volunteers, and attenders have to wear masks?

Yes. Face coverings (covering both the mouth and nose) are required for all staff, volunteers, and attenders, unless they are on stage. Those on stage will wear masks when they are not leading worship or speaking. We will also continue to offer live-streamed services for those who do not want to wear face coverings. Cloth masks and disposable paper masks are acceptable. Masks are also required for all kids ages 3 and above and are not recommended for children under 2. Although we encourage you to bring your own, we will have masks available, if needed.

Will each person have to have their temperature taken?

Our staff and volunteers will have their temperatures taken upon their arrival by the Safety Team. For the safety of others, anyone with a temperature over 100 degrees will be sent home. Attenders are asked to self-screen at home and should not attend Church on Campus if they or anyone in their househould are ill. All children 5th grade and under will be required to have their temperature taken to be checked into children's programming. Parents of Junior High and High School students will be encouraged to assess their students at home before sending them to any programming.

How often will the Sanctuary and other rooms be disinfected?

All rooms on campus will be cleaned and disinfected after every use. The Safety Team will clean high traffic areas throughout Sunday mornings. The children's and youth staff will disinfect toys, game controllers, pool cues, etc. after every use.

Why is there only Children's programming at 10:30 AM?

First, we want to ensure that we can implement our safety procedures well with your children for one service, before we expand to two. Second, moving to two services is stretching our volunteer capacity to the maximum. Therefore, we need time to recruit some new, wonderful children's volunteers to staff a second hour.
