- 2. Why did Jesus pose the question about the Messiah being the son of David? What is Jesus revealing about himself by recalling Psalm 110:1? Luke 20:41-44
- 3. How are followers of Jesus supposed to respond to persecution? Luke 21:12-19
- 4. What are we supposed to learn from the parable of the trees? What were the things that would happen within a generation of Jesus's death? Luke 21:29-33
- 5. What was the challenge the chief priests had in arresting Jesus that Judas could solve? Why does Luke comment that it was Satan who entered Judas? Luke 22:1-6
