



Safety Protocols:

(Updated 11/18/2020)

While Orange County is in the Purple Tier, RDFKidz Ministry will follow the cohort guidelines, as outlined by the California Department of Public Health and similar to the guidelines followed by local public and private schools. Children and youth will be interacting with a small group of 14 or less children and up to 2 supervising adults. RDFKidz Ministry will be providing programming to these cohorts both outdoors and indoors, as necessary.

In addition:

- Rooms will only be filled to 25% capacity.
- Maintain social distancing, as much as possible - The CDC recommends social distancing of 6 feet between individuals from different households. Rose Drive Friends Church's Children's staff and volunteers will do their best to encourage social distancing between children. However, we recognize that social distancing will not always be possible. Minors' attendance at Rose Drive Friends Church programming is at the parents discretion and understanding.
- Face masks are required for staff, volunteers, and children. Masks are not required for children age 2 and under, those with medical conditions, the hearing impaired, and those with mental conditions.
- All staff, volunteers and children will have their temperatures taken upon arrival and sent home if over 100 degrees.
- Parents will be encouraged to self-assess their children before sending them. Please keep sick children home. Children will be isolated and sent home if they show signs of illness.
- Upon arrival, all children will be asked to wash their hands in the restrooms.
- All doors (except restroom doors) will stay open to promote air flow.
- Cleaning: Phoenix Services, our custodial crew, will clean the floor, tables, chairs, etc. and the restrooms after the room is used. Staff will be responsible for cleaning all toys and other supplies after each meeting. Drinking fountains will be closed.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed in each classroom.
- Signs communicating expectations and the liability release will be posted.
- Only individually-wrapped, pre-packaged snacks and water bottles will be served.
