GROUP QUESTIONS

Acts 1:1 - 3:26

- 1. In what ways did Jesus prepare and equip His apostles to continue His ministry and life on earth? [Acts 1:1-5]
- 2. What was going to be the result of the Holy Spirit coming on them? [Acts 1:6-11]
- 3. Why do you think prayer seemed to be the major activity that they engaged in after the disciples returned to Jerusalem? [Acts 1:12-26]
- 4. The church that started in Jerusalem at Pentecost was in many ways an ideal church. What were some of its characteristics that our churches today would do well to imitate? What difference do you think it would make if the Holy Spirit were withdrawn from your life and your Christian community? [Acts 2:22-24; 36-41]
- 5. What are the spiritual results of the outpouring of the Spirit? [Acts 2:42-47]
- 6. In Peter's second "sermon," he directed the crowd's attention away from the healing and the apostles themselves, and instead on the uniqueness of Jesus. How do each of the titles he attributes to Jesus speak to this uniqueness? [Acts 3:11-26]

PRAYER: Praise the Lord Jesus for who He is and specifically for what is revealed about Himself in this passage. Ask the Holy Spirit to prepare you for and minister to you through this time.
