Acts 8:1-10:48

- 1. In chapter 1, Jesus commanded the disciples to be witnesses in Judea and Samaria. In chapter 8, what are the causes that leads to the spread of the gospel? [Acts 8:1-25]
- 2. How was Simon the Sorcerer's life affected by the "good news"? [Acts 8:5-13]
- 3. What do we learn about Philip's faithfulness and how had the Holy Spirit prepared the journey and encounter with the Ethiopian? [Acts 8:26-40]
- 4. In what ways does Saul's conversion demonstrate the grace of God? [Acts 9:1-19]
- 5. In what ways does Cornelius' encounter with God teach us about God? [Acts 10:1-8]
- 6. Of all the things that persuaded Peter he should violate Jewish law and enter the house of a Gentile such as Cornelius, which do you think could have been the most important? [Acts 10:19-29]
- 7. How does your "faith story" compare or contrast to Saul's and Cornelius'? How are you continuing to experience the grace of God in your life?
