Acts 11:1-15:21

- 1. Peter again learns about God's desire to take the gospel to all people, including Gentiles.

 Trace the process. In what ways do you see unity growing within the church? [Acts 11:1-11]
- 2. What can we learn from the Antioch Church? List 3 or 4 important characteristics. Compare Barnabas, Simeon, Lucius, Manaen and Saul along with the location of Antioch. [Acts 13:1-3]
- 3. How do Paul and Barnabas respond to the crowds' reaction? [Acts 14:1-28]
- 4. Gentile believers were being welcomed into fellowship by baptism without circumcision they were becoming Christians without becoming Jews first. Why was this issue so important? [Acts 15:1-21]
- 5. What might be comparable issues in today's church?
