- 1. What caught Paul's attention immediately about Athens? [Acts 17:16-34]
- 2. How does Paul open his sermon at the meeting of the Areopagus? What is the significance to Athenians that God is the creator of the universe? Why is it important to Paul to tell people that God is the sustainer of life? [Acts 17:22-23]
- 3. How does Paul call the Athenians to repentance? [Acts 17:22-31]
- 4. What do we learn about Paul in Acts 18? (vs.1-4) Paul shares with the Jews how did they react and how did Paul respond (vs. 6-15)? [Acts 18:1-15]
- 5. As we read about Paul's ministry in Ephesus, what good fruit do we see? [Acts 19:1-22]
- 6. What are the stated reasons and the real reasons for opposition to Paul's message? [Acts 19:23-41]
- 7. How did Paul describe himself and the ministry among the Ephesians? What does Paul instruct the leaders to do (vs. 28-31)? [Acts 20:18-35]
