- 1. Paul and his companions have been received warmly at Jerusalem. How would you describe the interaction between Paul and James? To what extent were both men willing to go for the sake of Jewish-Gentile solidarity? [Acts 21:18-26]
- 2. In Paul's bold defense, how does he demonstrate sensitivity to the crowd? [Acts 21:37-22:29]
- 3. How do you see God continuing to protect Paul? [Acts 23:12-35]
- 4. What three charges are lodged against Paul by Tertullus (vs. 5-6)? How did Paul speak to each of these accusations? What four affirmations did Paul state (vs. 14-16)? [Acts 24:5-16]
- 5. Why did Felix not come to any decision about Paul? [Acts 24:26-27]
