- 1. What kind of a person is Festus based on his description and actions? What is his expressed representation of Christianity? [Acts 25:1-22]
- 2. Why does Paul say that he is on trial? [Acts 26:6-8]
- 3. What is Paul's commission from Jesus Christ? What is Paul's desire and commitment to this commission again communicated in his final interaction with Agrippa? [Acts 26:15-29]
- 4. How does Paul reach out to those around him while they travel to Rome? [Acts 27:9-10, 21-26, 31-36]
- 5. What do you think it means that "boldly and without hindrance" Paul preached the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ? [Acts 28:31]
