Romans 8:18 - 12:1-8

- 1. If someone were to ask you how a good God could allow suffering in the world, how might you use Paul's words to respond? [Romans 8:18-39]
- 2. If someone were to ask you why some will be saved others not, how might you use Paul's words to respond? [Romans 9:14-24]
- 3. If someone were to ask you how they might be saved, how might you use Paul's words to respond? [Romans 10:9-13]
- 4. What does Paul want the Gentiles to know about the Israelites? [Romans 11:11-18]
- 5. What do you think Paul means when he says: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind?" How might this apply to the Jewish and Gentile Christians in Rome? [Romans 12:1-2]
- 6. In what way is serving God through one's gifts different than depending on your status? [Romans 12:3-8]
