## GROUP QUESTIONS

Romans 12:9 – 16:27

1. How does Paul see love playing out in everyday life? What is one aspect of love from Paul's list that feels challenging to enact? [**Romans 12:9-21**]
2. According to Paul, how should we respond to the authorities in our context? Why do you think Paul includes this section? [**Romans 13:1-7**]
3. How should Christians handle disagreement over belief and practice? What is the role of grace? What is the role of conviction? [**Romans 14:1-6**]
4. What does Paul say about accepting people into the body of Christ? What is our primary reason for doing so? [**Romans 15:7-9**]
5. How does Paul's final benediction summarize key points of the rest of the letter? [**Romans 16:25-27**]
