1 Corinthians 1:1 – 7:16

- 1. What evidence does Paul point to that the Corinthian church is divided? How might this same sentiment exist in the church today? [1 Corinthians 1:10-13]
- 2. Why would both Jews and Greeks see the cross as foolishness? Why does God choose what seems weak and foolish to the world? [1 Corinthians 1:18-25]
- 3. How do Christians attain wisdom? Why does Paul think this is important? [1 Corinthians 2:6-11]
- 4. Why does Paul tell the Corinthian church to focus on the morality of the people inside the church rather than outside of it? What might this mean for us today? [1 Corinthians 5:9-13]
- 5. Why does Paul take sexual immortality so seriously? [1 Corinthians 6:12-20]
- 6. What convictions about the purpose of marriage might exist behind Paul's commands on marriage, divorce, and marriage to unbelievers? [1 Corinthians 7:8-16]
