1 Corinthians 7:17 – 11:16

- 1. What advantages in remaining unmarried does Paul express? How might this passage speak to people who are single in our churches today? [1 Corinthians 7:25-35]
- 2. How might the exercise of our freedoms hinder the faith of another Christian? What should be our response? [1 Corinthians 8:4-13]
- 3. Why does Paul refuse to take money for preaching the gospel? What point does he want to make to the Corinthian church? [1 Corinthians 9:3-6, 15-18]
- 4. What is Paul's approach to helping people from different backgrounds experience the gospel? How might we take a similar approach in our culture? [1 Corinthians 9:19-23]
- 5. What are the guiding principles for the kinds of activities Christians should partake in? [1 Corinthians 10:23-24, 31-33]
- 6. In our culture, Paul's discussion about head coverings can feel "outdated". How might this passage have been helpful to the church in Corinth? [1 Corinthians 11:3-16]
