- 1. What was wrong with the way some people were celebrating the Lord's Supper? Where might this problem exist in the church today? [1 Corinthians 11:17-22, 33-34]
- 2. Why do you think that Paul uses the image a body to describe the church? What lessons do we learn from this analogy? [1 Corinthians 12:12-31]
- 3. Why does Paul put such a premium on love? What kinds of things might distract us from demonstrating love? [1 Corinthians 12:31 13:13]
- 4. Why does Paul desire order in worship settings? How might we apply Paul's words to our own worship contexts? [1 Corinthians 14:18-27]
- 5. What is the importance of resurrection for Christians? [1 Corinthians 15:12-22]
- 6. What can we infer about the Corinthian church from Paul's final instructions? [1 Corinthians 16:5-20]
