Galatians 3:15 – 6:18

- 1. Why does Paul tie the inheritance designated for God's people to the promise of Abraham, rather than the law? What purpose did the law serve? [Galatians 3:15-22]
- 2. What qualifies someone as part of Abraham's family (seed)? [Galatians 3:26-29]
- 3. What is the difference between a slave and an heir? What does being an heir means for how we live? [Galatians 4:1-9]
- 4. Why does Paul view circumcision as a negation of the value of Christ (v.2)? What is the freedom that Christ offers instead? [Galatians 5:1-6]
- 5. If Christ has set us free, can we do whatever we wish? What uses of our freedom bring us life? [Galatians 5:13-18]
- 6. How has Paul been building up to the fruit of the Spirit passage? How do we experience this fruit in our lives? [Galatians 5:22-26]
- 7. Why is it significant that we "do good"? Does this charge diminish the fact that we are saved through faith in Christ, or does it enhance it? [Galatians 6:9-10]
