GROUP QUESTIONS

Galatians 3:15 – 6:18

1. Why does Paul tie the inheritance designated for God's people to the promise of Abraham, rather than the law? What purpose did the law serve? [**Galatians 3:15-22**]
2. What qualifies someone as part of Abraham's family (seed)? [**Galatians 3:26-29**]
3. What is the difference between a slave and an heir? What does being an heir mean for how we live? [**Galatians 4:1-9**]
4. Why does Paul view circumcision as a negation of the value of Christ (v.2)? What is the freedom that Christ offers instead? [**Galatians 5:1-6**]
5. If Christ has set us free, can we do whatever we wish? What uses of our freedom bring us life? [**Galatians 5:13-18**]
6. How has Paul been building up to the fruit of the Spirit passage? How do we experience this fruit in our lives? [**Galatians 5:22-26**]
7. Why is it significant that we "do good"? Does this charge diminish the fact that we are saved through faith in Christ, or does it enhance it? [**Galatians 6:9-10**]

PRAYER: Lord, change our hearts so that we might become people who demonstrate the fruit of the Spirit toward all people and in all circumstances.
