3. What different roles exist in the church? What purpose do they serve? [**Ephesians 4:11-16**]
4. How are followers of Christ supposed to speak? [**Ephesians 4:25-32**]
5. What sort of actions against the command to "walk in the way of love" (v.2)? What actions are helpful replacements? [**Ephesians 5:3-5, 15-20**]
6. How does Paul's description of the relationship between husbands and wives connect to the rest of the book of Ephesians? Why is this important to Paul? [**Ephesians 5:21-33**]
7. What kind of opposition might Christians expect? What tools do we have against such opposition? [**Ephesians 6:10-18**]
