- 6. How does Paul's description of the relationship between husbands and wives connect to the rest of the book of Ephesians? Why is this important to Paul? [Ephesians 5:21-33]
- 7. What kind of opposition might Christians expect? What tools do we have against such opposition? [Ephesians 6:10-18]
