- 4. How does Paul feel about the Philippian Christians? Why does he feel this way? [Philippians 1:3-8]
- 5. How has Paul's imprisonment been a positive experience? [Philippians 1:12-14]
- 6. In what ways does Paul see both life and death as beneficial? How might we adopt the same posture as Paul? [Philippians 1:20-26]
- 7. What response should Christians have in the face of suffering? [Philippians 1:27-30]
