**Philippians 2:1 – 4:23** 

- 1. What elements of the "Messiah poem" are critical for understanding the gospel? [Philippians 2:6-11]
- 2. What character trait does Paul hope the Philippians Christians will exhibit? What is his justification for why they should have this trait? [Philippians 2:1-5 (See also 6-11)]
- 3. Why does Paul use the phrase "fear and trembling" to describe our posture as we work out our salvation? How does this relate to the command to not grumble or argue? [Philippians 2:12-18]
- 4. Why does Paul view his credentials as an outstanding Israelite as a loss? [Philippians 3:4-11]
- 5. How can Paul have the confidence to tell others to follow his example? How can we have the same confidence? [Philippians 3:17-21]
- 6. What does the peace of God mean for Christians? How do we get it? [Philippians 4:4-9]
- 7. What does Paul believe he can do through the Lord's strength? [Philippians 4:10-13]
