- 1. What are current examples in our culture of "hollow and deceptive philosophy"? How should followers of Christ react to them? [Colossians 2:6-8]
- 2. What impact did the cross have on the powers and authorities of this world? How might this impact our interactions with earthly powers? [Colossians 2:13-15]
- 3. What kinds of behaviors and patterns run contrary to God's Kingdom? Why does it matter that we avoid them? [Colossians 3:5-11]
- 4. What kinds of behaviors and patterns promote God's Kingdom? Why does it matter that we do them? [Colossians 3:12-17]
- 5. How are the instructions for households tied to the rest of chapter 3? [Colossians 3:18-4:1]
- 6. How should Christians act toward "outsiders"? [Colossians 4:2-6]
