2. Why does the author provide such a long list of people from the Bible who exhibited faith? What is important about the observation that “none of them received what had been promised?” [**Hebrews 11:2-40**]
3. How might we understand our faith in terms of God’s story throughout history? How is Jesus a part of this story? [**Hebrews 12:1-3**]
4. What does God’s discipline look like? How might we embrace it? [**Hebrews 12:5-13**]
5. What is the difference between the two mountains the author speaks of? How would this image have been helpful to the original readers? [**Hebrews 12:18-24**]
6. What are some traits that Christians should demonstrate? What are some ways in which God’s people can be led astray? [**Hebrews 13:1-9**]
