HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

OVERVIEW AND REVIEW

The "Overview" day(s) will help you first see the big picture of a book of the Bible before you start reading. Use a study Bible to learn the main themes, context, characters, book outline, why it was written, etc.

Your "Review" day(s) provide extra days to catch up on your reading or to more deeply reflect on what God is saying to you through scripture.

WALKING WITH THE WORD
