- 1. Continuing from 1 John, both 2 & 3 John call for caution and warning about "traveling" teachers who teach false doctrine and gospels as the concern of these letters. In 2 John verses 1-3, John mentions truth four times. What are the different dimensions of truth that John refers to?
- 2. The phrase "walking in the truth" is found in both letters (verse 4). What are the qualities in the lives of people who walk in the truth?
- 3. Jude also warns against false teachers promoting an immoral lifestyle and false view of Jesus. What spiritual practices help the church when false teaching is introduced?
- 4. What 3 different "tones" does Jude use throughout the letter? (v. 1-4, v. 5-11, v. 17-25)
- 5. Instead of fighting these false teachers, what does Jude call for in verses 20-21?
- 6. Where would you instruct followers of Jesus to exercise caution and wisdom against false teachings today?

<u>Prayer:</u> Use verses 20-21 to pray for yourself. Uses verses 22-23 to pray for others. **Jude** 

- <sup>20</sup> But you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit.
- <sup>21</sup> Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.
- <sup>22</sup> Be merciful to those who doubt;<sup>23</sup> snatch others from the fire and save them; to others show mercy, mixed with fear--hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.
